

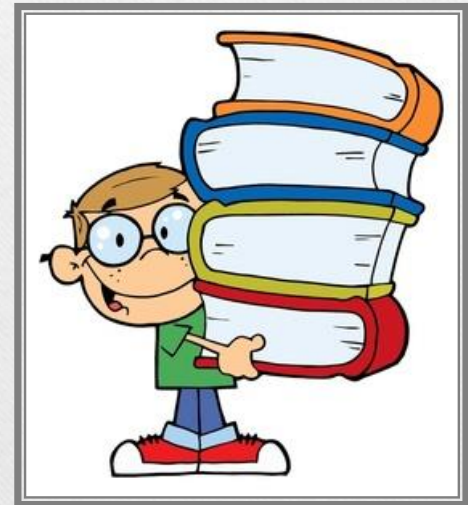
Reading Counts

Everything you need to know...



What is Reading Counts?

- Reading Counts is a Reading Incentive Program.
- Students select books from 70,000+ quizzes.
- Quizzes must be taken at school!
- Students take 10 question quizzes to assess their comprehension of the book.



Quizzes

- Quizzes are made up of 10 questions, no two quizzes are exactly alike, because there is a bank of 30 questions for the computer to choose from.
- You must pass with at least a 70% to get the points. That means you need to get 7 out of 10 correct!
- You can only earn points for a quiz one time.

QUIZ

Do's and Don'ts

- DO read the books carefully.
- DON'T try to take a quiz when you are not finished with the book.
- The majority of your points should be made up of books that you read independently.
- DO go slowly, DON'T rush!
- DO read books on your level
- DON'T watch a movie, take the quiz, and expect to pass.

How to choose an RC book...

- Know your reading level.
- Find a book with two labels. There is almost always a green sticker on the back of a reading counts book.
- Read the back of the book. Does it interest you?



Five Finger Test



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- Open the book to any page and begin reading.
 - If you come to word you do not know, put up one finger.
 - If you have no fingers up at the end of the page, that book is easy for you. If you have 5 fingers up, that book may be too hard for you.
